




Prayer


Purpose of Conversation

- The world is changing we need to find new ways to engage the community.




Continuing the Legacy Embracing the Future

- Restoring Organ (\$150K)
- Install Enhanced Sound System (\$25K)
- Create Accessible Worship Space (\$50K)
- Upgrade Kitchen (\$90K)
- Campaign Costs (\$35K)

Total Projects:

\$350,000



The Pipe Organ Preserving Traditions

- Beautiful, transcendent music is a cornerstone of Anglican worship
- Trumpets the first Easter Alleluias.
- Supports the Handel's Hallelujah Chorus that echoes through the church on Christmas morn.
- Memorial Day and Fourth of July patriotic medley with Hymns from the Armed Services
- Community sing-a-longs to show tunes and other favorites.




The Pipe Organ Engaging The Community

- Ensure future generations will experience transcendent and beautiful music in our sacred space.
- Become a destination in the greater Sacramento area for high quality, organ music
- Offer silent movie events to the community
- Unite people of divergent backgrounds and views by bringing the beauty of God more fully into our common life.



Welcoming All - Engaging the Community Integrated Audio, Video, Lighting

- Address Current Reliability Issues.
- Install Hearing Loop Compatible with Hearing Aids.
- Record High Quality Video and Audio of Sermons and Worship For Website.
- Host Community Movies and Silent Film Events.
- Broadcast to Guild Hall for families who need to step out of worship or funeral overflow.
- Light "dark" areas of church and improve energy efficiency.







Welcoming All Accessible Spaces

"This is God's table and everyone is welcome to join us for communion"

- Enable people of all ages & abilities to share communion with God and each other at the altar rail. Steps are currently a barrier.
- Provide seating space for wheelchairs.
- Create areas that invite and assure young families that they are welcomed.
- Arrange worship space so that young children can see and feel that they are connected to every part of the worship service.



A Commercial Kitchen

- Meals and fellowship are at the heart of this community - much of Jesus' ministry took place over meals, and ours does too!
- We currently use our kitchen to provide meals for the preschool program.
- Kitchen is not compliant with county code, so we use it in an ambiguous grayarea.
- Renovated kitchen will allow us to cook
 more and safely, engage the community
 and create additional sources of income.
 With these improvements we can cater
 events, cook for shelter residents, host
 cooking classes for children and youth and
 provide a kitchen incubator in our
 community.



A Commercial Kitchen

To increase functionality and comply with code:

- Install a code-compliant ventilation, fire suppression system and grease trap.
- Upgrade shelving to code-compliant open racks.
- Upgrade sinks/dishwasher to code compliant arrangement.
- Upgrade floor to code-compliant resilient flooring.
- Purchase commercial freezer.
- Seal and insulate south wall.



Preschool Campaign

- Re-develop outside play areas to create more natural space.
- Landscape entrance area and install security gate and signage.
- Implement electronic sign-in/out system.
- Purchase commercial freezer.
- Install new climate control system in classrooms
- Renovate bathrooms.




Phase Three

- Renovate Great Hall bathrooms and lobby.
- Install laundry facilities and unisex bathrooms with showers in basement to serve preschool and shelter program.
- Replace carpet and window in basement classrooms for expansion of preschool.
- Address acoustical, lighting and climate control issue in Great Hall.
- Install security doors between Great Hall and preschool.
